GETTING HERE

From the East (via the NYS Thruway/ Interstate 90): Take Exit 51 (NY 33 West) to NY 198 West. Exit NY 198 at Elmwood Avenue South. The college is immediately on the right. From the West or South (via the NYS Thruway/ Interstate 90): Take Exit 53 (Interstate 190) to NY 198 East, and exit at either Grant Street or Elmwood Avenue.

From the Buffalo Metro Transportation

Station (Bus/Greyhound): Exit the station and go north on Ellicott Street. Turn right on Clinton Street, then turn left on Elm Street. Enter onto Rt. 33 East. Exit onto Rt. 198 West (Scajaquada Expressway). Exit at either Grant Street or Elmwood Avenue.

From the Buffalo Exchange Street Train

Station (Train/Amtrak): Exit the station and go east on Exchange Street. Turn left on North Carroll Street, then turn left on Seneca Street, then turn right

From the North/Niagara Falls:

Take Interstate 190 South (over the Grand Island Bridge) to NY 198 East, and exit at either Grant Street or Elmwood Avenue.

From the Peace Bridge/Canada:

Take Interstate 190 North to NY 198 East, and exit at either Grant Street or Elmwood Avenue.

From the Buffalo Niagara International

Airport (Plane): Exit the airport onto Rt. 33 West. Exit onto Rt. 198 West (Scajaquada Expressway). Exit at either Grant Street or Elmwood Avenue.

on Michigan Avenue, then turn left on North Division Street, then turn right on Elm Street. Enter onto Rt. 33 East. Exit onto Rt. 198 West (Scajaquada Expressway). Exit at either Grant Street or Elmwood Avenue.

From the Buffalo-Depew Train Station

(Train/Amtrak): Exit the station and go north on Dick Road, then continue on Cayuga Road. Enter onto Rt. 33 West. Exit onto Rt. 198 West (Scajaquada Expressway). Exit at either Grant Street or Elmwood Avenue
