3+2 Program

This document describes the requirements for admission for students at Capital Normal University (CNU) to the SUNY Buffalo State – CNU 3+2 program for the Master of Arts (M.A.) program in Applied Economics at Buffalo State. The requirements described here are specific to the M.A. Applied Economics program, and are in addition to general requirements for the 3+2 program.

For admission to the Buffalo State – CNU 3+2 M.A. Applied Economics program, students must have completed or demonstrated the following:

Courses equivalent to:

- Principles of Macroeconomics
- Principles of Microeconomics
- Beginning Statistics
- Calculus for Social Sciences
- Intermediate Macroeconomics or Intermediate Microeconomics
- Accounting I
- Econometrics
- Calculus II

The above are minimum requirements. Recommended additional undergraduate courses are:

- Intermediate Microeconomics or Macroeconomics II
- Accounting II
- Corporate or Managerial Finance
- Investment Management
- One course in Computer Programming C , Visual Basic etc,
- Linear Analysis
- Differential Equations
- Real Analysis
- Additional Programming Courses

The requirements for admission listed here are for CNU students in the 3+2 program only.
