

Master of Science in Criminal Justice

3+2 Program

This document describes the requirements for admission for students at Xi'an Jiaotong University City College (XJTUCC) to the SUNY Buffalo State – XJTUCC 3+2 program for the Master of Science (M.S.) program in Criminal Justice. The requirements described here are specific to the M.S. – Criminal Justice program, and are in addition to general requirements for the 3+2 program.

For admission to the Buffalo State – XJTUCC 3+2 M.S. – Criminal Justice program, students must have completed or demonstrated the following:

Students admitted to the Buffalo State – XJTUCC 3+2 program leading to the M.S. Criminal Justice must be in the third year of a Bachelor's degree program at XJTUCC, and must have a grade point average (GPA) equivalent to at least a 3.0 on 4.0 scale (3.75 on a 5.0 scale). Students must have taken an undergraduate descriptive and inferential statistics course with an equivalent grade of 2.0 or above on a 4.0 scale and an equivalent passing grade on a 4.0 scale for an undergraduate research methods course at XJTUCC. Students must also submit a written statement of intent that addresses the applicant's preparation for graduate study. There are no deadlines for applications as they are accepted and evaluated on a rolling basis throughout the year.

The requirements for admission listed here are for XJTUCC students in the 3+2 program only.
